#### LITURGICAL MINISTRIES



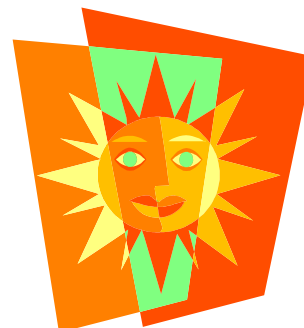

**Baptisms are held** on the 1st Sunday of the month. Preparation is on the 3rd Sunday of the month. Information from the Parish Centre.

**Marriages require** 6 months notice to one of the priests, participation in a FOCCUS marriage preparation program, or a Centacare Course. Information Forms at the Parish Centre.

**Anointing of the Sick** is held during Mass on the 1st Friday of the Month at 9am. Before going to hospital for major surgery, why not ask one of the priests to pray with you and anoint you.

**Children's Sacraments** require full participation in the preparation phase. Registration forms and Information from the Parish Centre.
